ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT USE OF FIRE ARMS & AIR GUNS Effective May 1. 1955

The Village of Martin Ordains

That the use of all fire arms, guns and the like including air guns, air pistols and the like, shooting shot, slugs and/or bullets shall be banned from use within the Corporate Limits of the Village of Martin, EXCEPT when done in an isolated location where there can be no damage to property or inhabitants, and then only under the direction and supervision of a regular Scout Leader or other instructor for educational purposes, and said leader or instructor must file his name with the Village Clerk, and take full responsibility for the actions of the group supervised.

Any person found guilty of the violation of this Ordinande shall be punishable under the law as follows:

1st Offense --- fine of \$5.00 and costs

2nd Offense --- fine of \$10.00 and costs

3rd Offense --- fine of \$25.00 and costs or imprisonment not exceeding 30 days, or both, at the discretion of the Court.

Any offender failing to pay the court-assessed fine and costs may be imprisoned not to exceed ninety days unless payment thereof be made sooner.
