VILLAGE PLANNING AND ZONING IMPLEMENTATION ORDINANCE

ADOPTED: <u>Sept 9</u>, 1974 EFFECTIVE: <u>Jan 29, 1975</u>

An Ordinance providing for the appointment of a Planning Commission to perform planning and zoning functions for the Village as authorized by Michigan Law; and for the repeal of any ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith.

THE VILLAGE OF MARTIN, ALLEGAN COUNTY, MICHIGAN, ORDAINS:

SECTION I.

This Ordinance shall be known as the Village Planning and Zoning Implementation Ordinance.

SECTION 2.

Purpose. The Village hereby declares its intent and does hereby come under the provisions of PA 1931, Number 285, as amended (being CL 48 Section 125.31, et seq) and does hereby appoint a Village Planning Commission to perform the duties and functions as provided in said act. The Planning Commission shall consist of nine persons to be appointed by the President of the Village, with the approval of the council by a majority vote, for terms of three years, with initial The Commission shall include the terms to be staggered. President of the Village, an Administrative Official of the municipality and another member of the Council, who shall be ex officio Commission members, and in addition thereto six persons appointed as provided herein. All members of the Planning Commission, with the exception of the ex officio members, shall be voting members and shall not have any elective or appointed Village office, except that one of said six persons may also serve as a member of the Zoning Board of Appeals.

The Commission shall proceed to prepare a Master
Land Use Plan as provided in said public act and shall perform
all of the duties and functions and have all of the authority
granted to a Planning Commission pursuant to said act. All
of the zoning functions and duties of the present Zoning Board
of the Village shall be transferred to the Planning Commission
at the time this Ordinance becomes effective. However, the
present Zoning Ordinance of the Village shall remain in full
force and effect, unless otherwise altered or amended hereafter
as provided by law. The Village Council shall determine hereafter by Resolution the rate and amount of compensation to be
paid the Planning Commission members.

SECTION 3.

Saving Clause. The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be separable. If any clause, sentence, word, section, or provision is declared void or unenforceable for any reason, by any court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect any portion of the Ordinance other than said part or portion thereof.

SECTION 4.

Repealing Clause. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5.

Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect on January 29, 1975.

SECTION I.

SECTION 3.

SAVING CLAUSE. The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be separable. If any clause, sentence, word, section, or provision is declared void or unenforceable for any reason, by any court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect any portion of the Ordinance other than said part or portion thereof.

SECTION 4.

REPEALING CLAUSE. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall take effect on January 29, 1975.
