Fall Leaf Disposal -Leaf vacuuming will start October 21st and continue until early morning November 18th. Leaves must be placed "BETWEEN THE SIDEWALK and STREET", but not in the street. Excess leaves in the street could clog our street drains and flooding will occur. At locations with no sidewalk, leaves should be placed near the edge of the street. Leaves may also be placed "in" paper or plastic bags for pick-up. Burning is still permitted, but not suggested as the smoke can cause discomfort for neighbors that may have respiratory problems. A burn permit from the County MUST be obtained before burning (Please call 686-5222). Our leaf machine is designed for **leaves only**. Please help us by keeping sticks, walnuts, trash, etc. out of the leaf piles....

Brush Pick-Up-In order for our DPW crew to change our equipment for the WINTER season, curb side brush pick-up of small quantities of brush and limbs (up to 4 feet in length and 2 inches in diameter) will end Tuesday morning November 11th. Brush must be set out the day before. Unless there is a major storm, we will not pick up brush again until Spring. Brush left by the curb side after November 11th will NOT be picked up.

<u>Hydrant Flushing</u>-Water hydrant flushing is scheduled for Friday and Saturday, October 10th and 11th. Residents connected to the village water system may experience discolored water. If you do, simply run water through a faucet until water clears.

Halloween -Halloween will be observed on Friday, October 31st. Trick-or-Treating should be limited to the hours of 5pm to 7:30pm. You are invited to attend The Fire Department's Open House from 5 to 7:30 that same evening. Come and enjoy free Hot Dogs, Brats, and many other treats.
